Oh, he said, My Chinese is Manderin. These people are all Cantonestan speaking. He said, I give all my sermons in English so they can understand. The church now has 2000 people. He is doing a wonderful work there. But as far as I know he is still speaking in English, because a good many of them will be Cantonese speaking Chinese. I believe that proper MUSAR when he was a student would have been the extra time needed to learn to speak English in a way that would be more understandable.

None of us speaks English as we should. We get bad habits as children, and we carry on those bad habits. We can improve in this and in 1000 other ways if we have MUSAR. May God gives us to work not simply to get degrees, not simply to get courses to get credits, but may God give us each one to look ahead at the ways we can serve the Lord, to think out how we can effectively do this, and to hunt in our courses for those elements which will be particularly useful in this regard, and to hunt for those ways in which we ourselves can learn to accomplish more for God.

Jesus's MUSAR gives us our shalom. Jesus wants us to follow in His steps. Despise not MUSAR but take hold of MUSAR. Let us pray:

O God our Father, we thank you for the Hebrew Bbble and the wealth of knowledge it contains. We thank you for the MUSAR that Jesus showed in living His perfect life, in resisting all that would have led him to sin, but in showing His sinless character and in giving His life on calvary's cross that we might be saved.

Help us not to act as thouse who beat the wind, but help us to act as those who will accomplish for Him. Help us to labor and toil and accomplish your purpose, but help us to learn how to accomplish it effectively.

Give us, we pray to take hold on MUSAR, and to be effective servants of Christ. We ask in Jesus' Name. Amen.
