

so I thought the way must be over!" Moral: get your facts straight. We need to go and work, but we need to do it intelligently. We need to get our facts. How many of us get things mixed up.

That's why we think it's worthwhile to spend 3 years in seminary getting a start, learning to get the Biblical facts straight, and then you need to get the facts about the people whom you are to pastor straight, whether you are a full-time pastor, whether you are in some other phase of so-called Christian work, or whether you are in secular work. God wants you to be a pastor, and he wants you to get your facts straight.

He doesn't want you to think the war is over and to kick somebody when what they need is comfort and consolation. He wants you to realize there are occasions when it is good to kick somebody and wake them up! We must know the facts and deal with them properly.

So he said, Go and make disciples of all nations. Teach them to obey everything I've commanded you. When you see the multitudes who know nothing of Christ, the multitudes who are humanistic. The educational system is turning away youth from all that America was founded upon and has stood for and it seems impossible.

Francis Schaeffer says that of all the other nations he has ever visited they are in far worse condition than our country is. Those people who feel that we are going to conquer the world, I feel sorry for them! Christ may choose to conquer the world, but it certainly does not look at present as if he's going to conquer unless it be by His own personal return.

He calls us to witness. He calls us to disciple. He calls us to get necessary relaxation but not to idle away our time. Work for the night is coming when no man can work. As we see the difficulties, as we see the problems, we'd feel it was hopeless if we did not realize that all authority has been given to Him. Surely I will be with you always. Let us realize His presence. Let us realize He will use us. We don't have to work in our own strength, in our own power, but we do have to work. But we do have to go and work in His strength. As we separate for the summer may he enable us to during this summer every one of us to accomplish much for Christ. May He enable us to lead souls to Him. May He enable us to help Christians to grow in grace. May He enable us to comfort those who are discouraged, to heal those with problems and with difficulties.

May He use us during the summer and bring us back again together to study His Word and learn to serve Him more effectively. Let us pray for those who graduate that God will lead each to the sphere of His choice and that Christ will go with each one of them.
