the time came they moved back to Chilocothe to a place just about 3 miles north of **i**t, bought a lot and built a building there and within a few months those 50 earnest, consecrated people had brought in enough others that they had a church of 250 earnest Christians seeking to do the Lord's work.

Some of you have got that kind of iniative, but have you got the determination? Have you got the willinginess to go through the privations of that sort of thing to build a church? Most of you have not. I praise God for those whohave. But for most of you when you graduate from seminary you will look to someone to support you. You will look for a source of working with others. You will look for a base.

One man graduated from us 15 years ago. He went out and got a little church. It was sturggling alone. He worked and toiled there for years and years and worked on the side to support himself. Now the church has grown to the place where it is supporting him full time. He'shaving a great work there.

Mr. Eckelmann, whom many of you are aware of. He earned his living through electricity and electronics. He had energy but he had energy few of us have to do a full time work that way and at the same time to reach out and reach students for Christ, to build up a discouraging work, because as he used to say, Every year half my church graduates and leaves and I have to start all over again! He has sent many students here and many a man has gone on with the Lord because of his pioneer work to lead them.

I wish we had a thousand to go into great colleges and universites among our students and do a work like Mr. Eckelmann. has done. But for most of us it will be important that we work with others. An organization is an important item. I don't think we should have one big church. I think that would be a mistake. I think that would put too much power in any small group of people's hands. But if we are going to accomplish most of us, we will need to be in an organization where a number work together. And Where if one of us slips we have others to support us in that and to help us and to encourage us.

We had a student who graduated not many years ago and I said, What are you going to do? He said, I am going to take a program for training a certain group he named. He said I am going and work assisting a pastor during the week, then one day a week we all come together and they give us lectures and we discuss our problems. He was very thrilled about this internship program he was going to have.

Then I saw him a little later and asked him how is the internship program &m coming. He said, They asked me to make
