in order that they can go out and seize these countries and not have to buythe grain and food for their people but simply take it from them. That's what happens when a system is developed that forgets God.

I've known people who say, You can't prove that God exists; you have to presuppose it. Personally I think that's a silly idea. Why should you presuppose Christianity more than presuppose Mohammedianism? or Buddhism? We don't presuppose anything. Paul said, The signs of God's existence are plain so so that anyone should recognize that God is. David said, The heavens declare the glory of God. We cannot look at this universe and not see that there is a divine hand, behind it, that there is a mind that has established it. How blind people are.

I once had a secretary who worked in Wilmington. She had a job before she came to me, for a Chemist in the DuPont Co. As he gave her material which mentioned various chemical things she said to him, I'd like to know a little about this what I'm writing about. Could you recommend a book that I might be able to understand? He recommended a book toher which told about the different chemical elements and how they had been discovered. She said it was fascinating reading, but in ch. after ch. it would tell about some chemical element and how it was discovered, and how it works and something about it and the ch. would end saying, We must marvel at the great intelligence of the scientists who were able to discover this element and to discover how it works.

She said, How much more marvellous that God who created the elements and caused them to work in this way! But, she said, never once inthis book was any recognition given to the God who had thus created it.

Fred Hoyle is the noted Britist astronomer holding an important position as professor of astronomy in Great Britain Many years ago he was invited also to be professor of astronomy in California. He would spend half the year at one and half theyear at the other. Fred Hoyle was one who was anxious to prove there is no Creator. Fred Hoyle took a strong stand against the idea of a creator. He invented a system that == a system of astropomy, he and a few colleagues, which was widely taught a few years ago. They called it the Steady State Theory. In other words all the universe continues about as it is now and always has continued just about as it is. There always == There was no creator and start to it.

That Steady State Theory involves the destruction of certain stars and galaxies, which is a clearly established fact, how then are they replaced? He said in all the universe there is certain material that gradually comes together to make new galaxies to replace the old ones. Many of the greatest astronomers adopted this theory, but today practically every
