evangelist who will use every means possible to bring His truth to the hearts and minds of those who do not know it or do not obey it.

In one feature Athanasius and Boniface were strikingly alike. Each of them regarded God as his master and feared nothing more than that he should allow a human motive to influence him to be untrue to his divine allegiance. Boniface wrote the popes of his day stating most fearlessly his condemnation of that which he considered wrong in their attitudes. Like Elijah he stood before God and did not fear any man. As Athanasius stood for the whole councel of God with a single eye and refused to be moved from that position though all the world seemed to be against him, as Boniface carried the truth where it was not known despite all obstacles of physical circumstances for human opposition, may you combine these qualities of these two great witnesses and to the utmost of your ability declare the Gospel of Christ. 3.
