to do our best to serve him and to forward his cause. It is just as much our duty to serve him with our intelligence, with our planning, wise, careful planning, as it is our duty to serve him with our hands, with our feet, with our mouths.

God gives us the Bible, not as a queer guide which we are to open up, place our finger on a verse and follow it, but as something from which we are to learn axhaskan the lesson of his messages given to mankind and purposes for this world. Then we are to undertake with every ounce of intelligence we have may have to make every ounce of energy of our being and every bit of talent he may have given us to work together for the accomplishment of those purposes which he made for us or which remain?

What we feel like/very often simply as the result of our inner inhibitions, perhaps as the result of what we had for dinner the day before. Not our feelings are the guide, but his word. We are to study his purposes, and to attempt in every way possible to make them effective.
