

indications of immediate turning to right or left of the trail. It does not always go into the straight path as may be done more easily when one is putting up fence posts. The point ~~here~~ is that we are not here putting up posts; we are trying to follow those indications which are already here. These indications may shift off and detour to the right or to the left, They may have a side trip of great importance, or they may go over easier terrain^{even} by going a little further. So it is well to keep one eye on the distant goal, but to keep another carefully on the immediate situation. By putting the two together, we follow our correct interpretation.
