

The Parallel's in Is. 31: & 30:

I. 30:1 Woe to the rebellious children, saith Jehovah, that take counsel,
but not of me; and that make a league, but not of my Spirit, that
they may add sin to sin;

31:1 Woe to them that go down to Egypt for help, and rely on horses, and
trust in chariots because they are many, and in horsemen because they
are very strong, but they look not unto the H. One of Israel, neither
seek Jehovah!

II. 30:2 that set out to go down into Egypt, and have not asked at my mouth;
to strengthen themselves in the strength of Pharaoh, and to take
refuge in the shadow of Egypt!

31:2 Yet he also is wise, and will bring evil, and will not call back his
words, but will arise against the house of: the evil-doers, and ~~as~~
against ~~and~~ the help of them that work iniquity.

III. 30:9 For it is a rebellious people, lying children, children that will
not hear the law of Jehovah;

31:6 Turn ye unto him from whom ye have deeply revolted, O children of
Israel.

IV. 30:33d,e. the pile therof is fire and much wood; the breath of Jehovah,
like a stream of brimstone, both kindle it.

31:9b ..whose fire is in Zion, and his furnace in Jerusalem.
