<u>Mr. STEELE</u>: Dr. MacRae, you have said quite a bit about Science here but we often hear people talking about the conflict between science and religion. Have you anything to say about that?

Well, Mr. Steele, you do hear a lot of conflict of theence and religion. Dr. MacRae: Actually, the God who is the real author of the Bible is the same one who has created everything and therefore it would be strange if there we any real conflict between these. onflict However, there is often between the ideas of science and the ideas of religious people. Science makes mistakes -- religous people amke mistakes -- good earnest Bible students sometimes misinterpret the Bible. If you get what the Bible really means and you get what the facts of science are, not just the theory they are built on, you will find they will always fit together because God is the author of both of them. Now, at Faith Seminary here in Philadelphia, we have a group of earnest young men that come to learn how to prove the Word of God, but we will always try to get these young fellows to study the facts and see just what the facts of the Bible and the facts of science -- what they really are, What we know and what we do not know, not to go beyond the actual facts. These fellows go down into the City of Philadelphia, go to the great University Libraries and the museums and any other opportunity they have to see just what the facts are. We are not afraid of science because we know that and the Bible true science/always will fit together.
