- 1. The Tribulation. In Mat. 24.29-31 the coming of the Son of Man is said to be immediately after the Tribulation
- 2. The Antichrist. In 2 Thess. 2.8 Antichrist is to be destroyed with the brightness of Christ's coming. The context shows he is to be revealed before Christ's coming

The setting up of the Abomination of Desolations is related to the activity of this last of earth's most awful tyrants. Dan. 9.27

The doom of this beast is sealed by the second coming of Christ, Rev. 19.20 see context, vs. 11-19

- 3. Wonders in the heavens and in the earth: blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke. The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and terrible day of the Lord come. Joel 2.30-31; Acts 2.17-20 cf. Mat. 24. Ik. 21.25-28
- 4. Behold, your house is left unto you desolate. For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord. Mat. 23.37
- 5. After taking out from the gentiles a people for his name "After this I will return, and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again its ruins, and I will set it up: Acts 15.14-16
- 6. Jerusalem shall be trodden down by the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled. Lk. 21.24
 And the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months, Rev. 11.1-2
- 7. The Seal, Trumpett and Vial judgments of Rev. 6-19
- 8.All nations of the earth gathered together against Jerusalem Zech. 12.3,9 I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle, Zech. 14.2 Then the Lord shall go forth and his feet shall stand in that day upon the Mount of Olives (14.4f)
- 9. This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come Mat. 24.14
