

- Mark 13.28 Now learn a parable of the fig tree: When her branch is yet tender, and  
29 putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is near: So ye in like manner,  
30 when ye shall see these things come to pass, know that it is nigh, even  
at the doors. Verily I say unto you, that this generation shall not pass,  
till all these things be done.
- Luke 13.6- He spake also this parable: A certain man had a fig tree planted in his  
7 vineyard; and he came and sought fruit thereon, and found none. Then said  
he unto the dresser of his vineyard, Behold, these three years I come seek-  
ing fruit on this fig tree, and find none: cut it down; why cumbereth it  
8 the ground? And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year  
9 also, till I shall dig about it, and dung it: And if it bear fruit, well:  
and if not, then after that thou shalt cut it down.
- Luke 21.29- And he spake to them a parable; Behold the fig tree, and all the trees:  
32 When they now shoot forth, ye see and know of your own selves that summer  
is now nigh at hand. So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to  
pass, know ye that the kingdom of God is nigh at hand. Verily I say unto  
you, This generation shall not pass away, till all be fulfilled.
