Also, in 32-33 32 to 33 He says that when the fig tree puts forth its leaves you know summer is near, and similarly, when you see these things, you know that it is near, even at the door.

Luke gives us a similar indication about a fig tree. In Luke 21, a kk chapter that is to quite an extent parallel to Matthew 24, we have a similar figure taken from the budding of the fig tree. In Matthew 24, verse 15, a statement is made:
