Every real Chn° believes in the covenants that are than taught in SerietungeScripture, and every real Chn° believes in the dispensations that are taught in Scripture. The question ts xx how many covenants and how many dispensations. On either of these two questions no gm dogmatic answer can be given, for Scripture does not give a precise answer to either of them. There are covenants in Scripture that are absolutely clear and definite. There are dispensational lines in Scripture that are absolutely clear and definite. There are hints an covenants places where it seems reasonable to infer a covenant, but, one has no right to be dogmatic, at least as far as the use of the title is concerned, or as to the duration of the covenant. Similarly there are places where it may/km reasonable to infer a difference of dispensation, but there is great possibility that earnest Chns differ as to the interpretation. All who sincerely and earnestly try to follow the Scripture and accept what it teaches believe in covenants, and also in dispensations. The terms are not valid terms for dividing people Chn teaders into groups at variance with one another. Those who may be selected as typical representatives of w either group might list anywhere from five to a dozen specific beliefs that they would EME consider to be distinctive of the viewpoint, but on careful examination s it would be found that those w on which great certainty could be held were accepted by and that there a number of Mull intelligent holders of both views groups in each side which would xeek rest on very scanty evidence. It is not God's will (how do you know?) Surely it is not God's will

thus thus that we should/divide into opposing camps, but that those of us who believe in the truth of the Scripture kanning should stand on what is clearly taught
