

He puts 11, ~~the=first~~, most of 11 in L, but the last part, ~~the~~ "what have you done to us that you brought us out of Egypt?" he gives to J. He continues then with J through 12 and 13 and 14; he puts 15 in L, and the first words of 16, ~~but you~~ "but you lift up your staff" and then the rest of the verse he gives to E. Under E he places 17 and 18 in ~~xxxxxxx~~ Italics. He gives 19 to E, except the last third of the ~~xxx~~ verse which he gives to J. From here on he intersperses very rapidly back and forth between J and E.
