He puts 11, the=first; most of 11 in L, but the last part, Xk "what have you done to us that you brought us out of Egypt?" he gives to J. He continues then with J through 12 and 13 and 14; he puts 15 in L, and the first words of 16, kmtxymm "but you lift up your staff" and then the rest of the verse he gives to E. Under E he places 17 and 18 in *ittraxxiti* Italics. He gives 19 to E, except the last third of the xxx verse which he gives to J. From here on he intersperses very rapidly back and forth between J and E.
