Story of Ishmael and Isaac given by E in ch. 21 is a variant account of the narrative from J found in ch. 16

Account of Abraham's preparations to sacrifice Isaac, has no parallel in the J tradition. Regarded as the classical portion of the E materials. J may have had his own version, but if so that version has disappeared.

- p. 65 The P account of the covenant with Abraham (ch. 17) shows/much later age than does that found in E materials of ch. 15
- p. 67 Harrelson puts Gen. 38 in J, not in S, as does Pfeiffer and says that Pfeiffer's view is "hardly correct."
- p. 70 Joseph in Egypt, Gen. 39 48 "Occasional discrepancies and some unevenness of style" Very few "outright contradictions"
