His coming complete victory and future reign. Psalm Eight shows Him as the Son of Man. Psalm 22 describes the crucified Saviour, dying for our sins. Psalm 23 presents Him as our companion and protector in this age. Psalm 24 describes His coming kingdom. Psalm 72 depicts His reign. The prophetic books have much to say about Him. Time after time He appears in Isaiah. In Is. 2 we see a picture of His great millennial reign. In ch. 4 we see His presence to protect His people in all ages. Chapts 7 and 8 He appears as the Virgin born Immanuel. In ch.9 He is described as the Child who is born, the Son who is given whose Name is Wonderful, Counsellor, the Mighty God, the Everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace. IN Ch. 32 begins with a picture that combines His reign as king with His activity as Good Shepherd caring for His people. Ch. 53 gives the picture of His atoning death so clearly one would think that Isaiah was actually observing it. I Ch. 55 contains as wonderful a Gospel call as can be found anywhere in the Bible. Micah predicts His birth in Bethlehem and declares that "He shall stand and feed in the strength of the Lord, in the majesty of the name of the Lord His God . . . for now shall He be great unto the ends of the earth, and this man shall be Peace."
