

currency on the boat or on landing before one reaches a bank. Usually the purser can change U. S. dollars or traveller's checks into whatever currency is needed.

15. Currency not needed on the voyage and other valuables including traveller's checks taken on the boat should be deposited with the purser for safe keeping on the voyage. The purser will issue a receipt and will deliver all such to passengers whenever requested.
14. Missionaries at home on furlough cannot expect the Board to pay their travelling expenses after they have reached their destination. Such travel should be arranged for and paid privately. However, it sometimes is possible to arrange speaking engagements along the route one wishes to follow and the Board will be very happy to aid in this as far as it can.
