(II K.8:17) The difficulty is removed if we suppose the numbers in the Hebrew text of Chronicles were transmitted by letters. 40 and 2 would be n + n; 20 and 2 would be 2 + n. It is not easy to to think that the  $\mathfrak{D}$  would have been mistaken for a  $\mathcal{D}$ , but in early days they were more similar, as a few examples (from Gesenius' Grammar) will show:
