Dear Dr. Robbins:

Thank you for your letter of September 13th. You will find enclosed a brief pamphlet which I have written on the matter of the Apocraypha. I hope that you will find it satisfactory.

When anything is published under my name I always insist that it appear in exactly the form in which I write it, with no addition or subtraction or alteration, even of a comma. This does not mean that I would not be glad to remedy any errors that might be found or to shorten the material if it should be thought to be too long. I am always very glad to listen to suggestions, but feel that I have a scholarly reputation to uphold, and therefore that anything that has my name on it should appear in exactly the form that has been approved by me.

Of course I am always glad to help in Christian movements and to give material to be published by someone else in such form as he chooses, so long as my name is not connected with it.

I hope that what I have written will be of help to you in your very important work. May the Lord bless you in all things.
