It might also be mentioned that frequently a cuneiform sign is used as a "determinative." By this we mean that it indicates the type of word that follows. Thus there is a determinative that precedes the name of a country, one for the name of a deity, one preceding the name of a man, another the name of a woman, one for mountains, one for wooden objects, etc.
