Personally I think that we should take each other's word as to his attitude toward the great central doctrine of salvation by faith, and not try to prove from implications of what he says, that he believes something he claims not to believe. Minor differences should be watters for toleration and free dis cussion, not for is bitter antagonism. The vital necessity to the presentation of the grace of God as par/only hope of a needy world, rather than the an insistence that one has the correct idea on all the aspects of the application of salvation. The difference between Luthernism and Calvinism is far less important than the difference between either of them and Modernism or Barthkanism.
