nothing of the sort is inted intended in it or properly derivable from its notes. There are others who rejoice in the word dispensationalism who divide the Bible up into many small sections which they say have men-- meaning only for p certain particular periods, leaving only a very small section of the New Testament as have- having relevancy for k Christians of today. This extreme type of dispensationalism is repute repudiated by the great bulk of Christian people.

When it comes to the term & Covenant Theology, this unfortunately is used by many different people in entirely senses. There can be no doubt that the New Testament teaches that God makes a coventa covenant with His people. When we believe on Him, we do not then rec-reciev- receive salvation and if our faith wonders a little loose the salvation and then have to be saved over again. If one is really saved and ace- accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as & Saviour there is no question but that God bas has entered into permanent covenant relationship with that person.
