longevity of the antediluvian patriarh patriarchs. All we know is that the Bible clearly states that they did live far longer than has been the case during most of the time since the flood.

I do not know of any archaeological material that relates to the period before the flood. It seems evident from the Bible that civilization before the flood had progressed to a far higher point than was reached for a considerable time after that event. If I and my family were to be the only people left alive after the complete destruction of all the other-inhabitans inhabitants of this earth, we would not know how to build new railroads and airplanes, but would have to live on a scale ks similar to that of some centuries ago, and it would probably be a long time before humanity

would rediscover many of the til things that have become a commonplace today.

I do not know of any archaeological evidence regarding situations or

events before the mi flood, This is not at all strange since we do not know for the way of knowing in what part of the earth people lived before the fill flood. It might have been almost a anywhere. In a year's time the ark may have moved very long distance.

It is true that much publicity was given about 30 years ago to a discovery in Mesp- Mesopotamia, where an excavator claimed to have found evidence of Noah's flood. There is no doubt, however, that the layer of rubble that he found was simply the result of a river having overflowed its banks, but considerable rubble had been deposited in a certain area, but no-con corresponding deposits were found in other areas along the river. It was altogether different frm-frm-- from Noah's flood. Furthermore, and the type of civilization represented below was above this particular flood layer were almost identical. There was no sign of any change comparable to that which occurred in connection with Noah's flood.
