1. Opposites - antithesis. Early view. Nominalistic

2. Independent; dualism. (Wittgenstein of action).

3. Finals Teleological

a) Nature is preordained to grace or super-nature.

b) Roman Catholic Church; Aquinas.

- nature & super-nature are in teleological sense; related to each other; supernature is end of the lower. (complete).

- nature is preliminary step to the higher.

c) Person can fulfill life within telos (nature) but not full complete until he rises to supernatural.

d) Natural theology is relatively independent; reason alone.
- operates in own principles; reason.
- can attain a certain knowledge of God by reason alone apart from anything else. Tells us that God is but no more.

- for complete view must have supernatural; a step up the ladder.

- nature is independent but is related to supernatural; this is teleological

- revelation is not basic for reasoning.

4. Organic Connection of Nature & super-nature.
