

we should have to make creation a correlative of the being of God; we would have to posit it creation.

The best solution is to think of these rel. att. come to expression in God's relation to His creation. They are the ways in wh. His essential and imminent att. are operative in connection with His handiwork in creation & providence. Although God is eternal & imminent in His being & perfections, He is not imminent in His relationship w.r.t. creation. The rel. att. are the relatives wh. arise from His own inherent & nec. perf. A rel. att. point always to an att. wh. is inher. & has meaning quite apart from creation. For instance the distinction immensity & omnipotence. means. is that wh. is imminent & essential to God's being. Omnipotence. is the effect of this immensity upon creation. Similarly re power & omnipotence; knowledge & omniscience. It is for this reason that the terms trans absolute & relative are not entirely satisfactory. All att. are absolute, in that they are essential, eternal, imminent, necessary. It is probably more accurate to dist between attrib. and predicates. Creation is not inherently nec. to God. Conseq. neither is prov, sel, redempt. These are all the effects of the sovereign will of His will. Eph. 1:11. In like manner when we think of att. in terms of God's relationship to the st. order, they can be correctly regarded as pred. rather than att. Conseq. the att. are those qualities inseparable from God's being. This goes. in round up. w.r.t. God's eternity in relation to time.

b. The att. may also be classified according to the method by which we come to know wh. the attributes are.

- i. via negation - to deny to God all imperfections
- ii. via eminential - to ascribe to God a supereminent degree all the virtues of men.
- iii. via correlatio - to ascribe to God those qualities wh. are indep. to the causation of all things.

All this requires a great deal of presupposition. There would be a tendency to anthropomorphize God.

c. Classification according to communicability. Comm. & noncomm. att. There are imminent att. but it is indirect & apart of comm. att. God does have His imprint on creation.
