i.e. the order of revelation, or distinction; that is another question. But this is the case in theological construction. Our concept of the unity must never be an abstract one which has the 3 merely tucked in. Our concept of unity cannot be framed except as it is conditioned by the 3 which belong to the unity. This is just saying that it is as sensible to ask why God is triune. There is nothing more ultimate than can be said than that God is (I AM). It is just as ultimate that God is Father, Son & H. S. Therefore in this this unity & diversity are equally ultimate. Before this mystery, the creaturely & humanly & adoringly bows.

c. Trinitarian distinctions. If He is 3, there must be some distinction; there are between Father, Son & H. S., there must be something that differentiates; some property that belongs to one and not to the other. These are incommunicable properties. The difference abides in the very titles, Father, Son & H. S. The Father alone is Father, the Son alone is Son, & the Spirit alone is Spirit. Paternity is the peculiar property of the Father, filiation the peculiar property of the Son, & procession is the peculiar property of the Spirit.

To be of none; neither begotten nor proceeding is the differentiating property of the Father. To be of the Father by generation is the distinguishing property of the Son. To be of the Father & the Son by procession is the differentiating property of the H. S. Hence the mode of subsistence. This is an order that can't be mixed & a property that can't be changed or communicated from one to the other. Personam igitur voce subsistuntiam in Dei essentia, quae ex aliis ulla proprieate incommunicabiliter distinguitur. (Calvin, Inst. I 13:6). "A person therefore I call a subsistence in the essence of God, which is related to the others & distinguished by an incommunicable property."

d. Inmanent distinctions. The inmanent properties are inmanent & eternal; not opera ad extra, but opera ad intra. This means they do not refer to the modes of operation in the economies of creation & prov. They are closely related. The Father is eternally Father;
