oppressor ceased; the golden city ceased." The Hebrew word which the Anthorized Version translated "golden city" is a word wheccurs nowhere else in the Bible. In order to derive it from a root for "gold" one has to assume that it is taken not from Hebrew but from Aramaic. The word for "city" does no occur at all. It has a prefix which suggests a plece, but which also is someties fued for an instrumentality. Tone of the ncient versions translates it "goluen city". The Anthorized Version has a margin which says "or exacters of gold". Here the idea of mold is still retained which probajly is not contained in the word at all. It is projably better to follow the Septugent.

The vory vivid picture contained in these verses describes the entry of Satan into the pit when he is cast down as max portraved in Revelation 20. "Hell from beneath is moved to meet thee at theming. All thy pomp is brought gown to the grave. How art thou fallen from heaven, oh Lucifer, son of the morning." The overreigning pride of Satan who thought that he would ascend avove the cloucs and world sit ron the mountains of the congregation in the places in the north is described in vivid language and then we see those smaller followers of his, leaders of nations who have tried to establish supreme power in the erth by wicked means as they welcome him into the pit at his fall.

Prom verses 21 to 22 we see the destruction of the family oi the evil one who has been described. $H_{e}$ is to have no successors. This certainly woulu not be a description of Tebuchadnezaar, the king of Babylon, for he was succeeded for two or tree apmerations. This is a picture of the overthrow of all the forces of wicredness and the fact that nome of them are to heve a lasting proginey but especialy thoop that Satan's ower is to come to a complete end. Anarg Again in verse 23 we soe the ploces of his dominion are doomed to atter notlingness.

Vrses 24 to 27 preant another note. Here we find the Lord declaring that the is going to brine deliv rence. Here He specifically speaks of Assyria. He is going to bring the Assyrian in Fis land. He declares that this is to be
