and archaeological discoveries has been found. It would be absurd to expect every verse in the Bible or even the majority of the verses to be corroborated by archaeology.

Even where the verse deals with a matter of history, it would be unantural to expect verbal correspondence between the statement of an Israelite about a contact between Israel and Assyria, and that of an Assyrian. Ea ch might know details wheich were unknown to the other. Each would select certain matters which he felt interesting and worth recording. Yet comparison often can bring out the a close agreement in the exxential facts, even while noticing that certain details of each record are simply not included in the sphere-
