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can't say it is right at hand. You don't know. The thing for you to do is to be faithful. Mr. Gustafson? Mr. Gustafson: Well, isn't that a compound subject there. You were speaking about the falling away revelation. and the revelation shall come, whatever that means. it seems to me we ought to include it. Dr. MacRae: Yes, all that must take place before Christ actually sets up His Kingdom. These people think Christ's Kingdom is going to be set up right now. Well, it won't be set up right now. All these things take place first, but is the rapture somewhere before the actual setting up of the Kingdom, a few years before, or is it right at the time? He doesn't enter into it one way or the other. He simply says, "Don't think the Kingdom of Christ is right now being set up. You don't know when it is going to be set up. Your business is witnessing, and the actual setting up of the Kingdom isomese after the falling away and the man of sin is revealed. the falling away and the revelation of the man of sin, he says both of them are in part of a process that's already working but the full culmination won't take place until something happens, and whether that something refers to the rapture or not, it doesn't say here that the Christian has definite signs that tell him when the rapture is to be. He wouldn't need to enter into that problem unless that particular thing is whole Mr. ---? Are you referring this day of the Lord to the complex of events or just

the rapture? Dr. MacRae: Well, of course, the problem is there that He is evidently dealing with something that is bothering them and what it is that is bothering them we don't know definitely, but the thing that they are disturbed about is they think the day of Christ is here now. Student: Was that the rapture? Dr. MacRae: Well, we don't know what they thought it was. I would question that it means the rapture, because how could you think the rapture was here now if you were still here? Some have said that these people thought the rapture had taken place and they were left, but that is reading a lot into the passage. Yes? (Student) If he hasn't told whether the rapture takes place a week before or a month before, a year before, a decade
