peopibe go into utter debauchery and wickedness, perhaps that would please him best but that is not what is effective. The effective thing is to get people all inspired and thrilled with religious enthusiasm and feel that they are serving God and Our Lady and devoting themselves to the service of God and Our Lady. Our Lord and Our Lady demand
(8.25) Our Lord and Our Lady. And devoting themselves to that with this zeal and determination XX and then going ahead on that basis. Now another thing to be noticed is that here you have a conflict between two systems, each of which has a certain strength and a $\notin$ certain weakness. Protestantism believes in individual interpretation. It has the strength of individual initiative in it and under three conditions it will always win. It has the strength which can never be duplicated in any tyranny. But on the other hand, the Jesuit system has the strength of a tyranny and the strength of a tyranny will often win out against the individual situation because the tyranny acts together as a solid force to overcome individual freedom. And the result is that over a short space of time the tyranny man completely win out. In the long run, or if those who believe in freedom will only stand together to put down tyranny, not to enforce the views of any of them but to put down tyranny, then it can continue. It's the situation in the world as a whole today. If the free nations simply sit back and each one hope it won't be the next one attacked by the Communists, the Communist tyranny will eventually conquer the whole world - inevitably. But if they would unite, not to enforce their ideas on any other nation, but to put an end to tyrannical
(9.75) and leave the nation and the people in those nations free to have the kind of situation they want, if they do that, then in the course of free discussion, their free views would win out. And
