the general council in Italy and having refused to not have a general council but to keep pope Leo friendship he said well we will let your representatives preside at it and so this is the first general council at which a representative of the pope presided . And so Leo representative presided at the general council , at Chalcedon , and not only did Leo's representative preside there but Leo sent a message in which he gave a very clear and definite statement of the matter of the person of Christ, the one person and the two natures and the fact that the two natures were not separated and not combined , they are a union in one person but there is not a separation of the natures,
