

So Gelasius exalted ~~claims~~ claims which he made are worth noting here although they are not particularly important ~~cause~~ there was nothing he could do about it the previous pope before him had excommunicated ~~him~~ the bishop of constantinople who has gone too far in the monophysite direction and excommunicated him and for the next 30 years there was no feeling between the church of Constantinople and the church of Rome, the two had excommunicated each other, and so Gelasius, simply means to depart from relationships from each other, of course if you excommunicate an individual a great organization individual and really has a strong effect on him and cuts him out of that church of its sacrament of that organization but for two churches one it maybe very important an individual can claim to excommunicate the church and it all depends how important he is ~~whether~~ (this record is not clear) But hear the two churches for thirty years are out of relationship with each other and Gelasius writes the emperor and the emperor has to do what Peter says and get him in line with the church of Rome and bring the church of the East but nothing happened about it.
