superiors in London. 4 recently appointed in Washington because you find that these officials out in Africa would very likely say well what are those fellows sitting in their swivel chairs in London, by the way, we didn't see any swivel chairs in the office and there were pretty plain chairs in London. Well, what do they know about our problems here? And that is just what has occurred and they haved turned down the applicatin of Mr. and Mrs. Armes for entering and they showed no indication of being willing to grant that land, but sent notice that the appeal would be

as soon as possible.

I don't know what but that is the situation that we face upon the foreign field. Now I just want to say one more thing in regard to that. God already has shown that He is able to give a great victory in that place. That decision of the British government, ther representations of the prime ministers and the whole cabinet considered it, that they would not require any mission or church to work through channels of theologically repugnant to it. That is a good phrase. That is a victory in itself. We had another mictory in London and Dr. McIntier pressed this in a way that some of us thought was perhaps going a little too far, and yet met withanother favorable reception and we praise God for it. He told those officials that while we were anxious as an International Council of Christian Churches to set this case in Kenya right, never the less, he said, that he is speaking, and we are speaking not merely for ourselves but for any mission and every mission that was truly representative Christian mission, if it was worthy, he said, that we weren't speaking for those who were off on some tangent, some ism, Jehovah Witnesses or anything of that kind, but he said for any mission withhich stood for Christianity, that mission should have the freedom of entrance and freedom of the proclamation of the Gospel and he mentiond the great thing that the Gospel had done for England.
