then naturally he again took put his support through the church of Constantinople and not to the church of Rome. In view of that you would rather think the story was not emphasized here, the fact that Phocus acknowledged the universal premacy of the seat of Peter, it is a half truth, but as you see standing alone, it is an utterly false imporession, so I think that it is well that you for today learn something about Phocus' character, how he became emporer and how he ended his empire and if it were not for the very wicked

of his character, I think that he would be emphasized probably much more in our encyclopedias in view of the support he gave to the bishop of Rome. Now we began last itme, #7, the seventh century and we noticed A, the conversion of A , we notice that Gregory sent Augustine over there, no relation to Augustane of Hippo, of course, he the message of christianity to the Germatic tribes that had conquered Asia and it is interesting that the Pope had tried a century before, two centuries before nearly, to win Ireland and his representatives had utterly failed and a mand from

Brittain had brought Christianity to Ireland and the Irish were the great headquarters of NON-Roman Christianity for three centuries, (question) (end of record)
