 - (1) To the women.
 - (2) To Mary Magdalene.

 Some scholars interchange (1) and (2).
 - (3) To Peter.
 - (4) To the two on their way to Emmaus.
 Uncertain which of (3) and (4) comes first.
 - (5) To the ten apostles with Thomas absent.
 - (6) To the eleven disciples with Thomas present.
 - (7) To the seven disciples at the sea of Tiberias. For order, cf. John 21:14.
 - (8) To the eleven disciples upon an appointed mountain in Galilee.

 Is this the appearance to five hundred mentioned in I Corinthians 15:
 - (9) To James.
 - For suggested order, cf. I Corinthians 15:5-8.
 - (10) To the apostles in Jerusalem on the occasion of a meal, Acts 1:4,5. (Or is this part of the next appearance?)
