IV. Methods of Christian Education

- A. Lecture-covers large amount of material. Used usually in large classes 1. Helps
 - a. Pictures, charts, maps, stories (illustrations)—gives truth hands and feet—conveys joy, sorrow, humor. See the Bible. Not an academic Book, a Book of Life and living (Ot.32:46,47); overhead, film strips, flammelgraph, and artifacts.
 - 2. Advantages:
 - a. Makes possible the effectiveness of the spoken word. Gives more dolor than the printed page. Alive!
 - b. Makes possible more effectual operation of the personality of teacher.
 - c. Arouses interest and motivates pupil. Hore effective appeal to amotions.
