

From ~~375 to 379~~ 379 to 395 he was emperor of the East and he towered so greatly in ability and leadership above any contemporary in the West that he was the great figure in the Roman Empire in that time. We will notice a number of important things about him before we are through. So much for this survey of the emperors from 363 - 395. I am not asking you to learn all these details but I would like to have you get some of these main names and dates down. Do remember the name of Valens which is very important and Theodotius I who is of tremendous importance and the name of Gratian, because we will touch upon two or three things he did later on.
