find an English expression which has just the same possibilities of interpretation as the Hebrew word has. Any language may have possibilites of interpretation that your Hebrew didn't have. So it is a very difficult thing than slating, making a decision between alternatives, and you have to decide on one or the other.

But from this riewpoint that the interpretation contains that on the whole the Authorized is a very excellent one. There are places where I can see they used definitely the wrong to the contains that their interpretis definitely wrong, but they knew their material and on the whole they did an extremely excellent job. I only wish that it were in modern English so that our people would be able to understand that what the interpretations really were.
