God has now revealed to Elisha that the time is now ready to carry out in detail the large order that has not been given. You might say that the orders given to Elijah down on Sinai were like the commands given to the American tropps before the invasion of France. All the detail s were worked out. The different divisions had practices what they were to perform. They knew knew exactly which were to land first and which were to land next and which were to do the particular duties and all that was worked out but no one was told when it would be done. That was a matter which was kept to be given by the Land when the prespx proper time arrived and would depend to quite an extent on weather conditions and other matters that could not be foreseen. In this case God, of course, could know exactly what the situation was going to be but handianits there is no evidence that he revealed all these details in that event. The ganeral orders were given. Now this specific time has come and the specific direction has been given to proceed to carry out the order. So just as the general order about Hazael was carried out we don't know how long before this time. We know that it was before this time. How do we know it was before this time? May it not be that simply the account of one of them is given and the account of another event without it being told specifically what order it occurred in? "uch things do happen you know. It isn't nedessary that you give things in chronological order. In fact, right in Kings we have one king carried through and then we hake the other kingdom and start back forty years. Now we have been dealing with the ancinting of a new king of Syria and we have come over to the story of the anointing of a new king of srael. How to we know whether the events of chapter 9 are chronologically later than the events of the middle portion of the chapter 8} How many here could think of a definite way in which we could know? Two, I see, three. Anyone else? Well, then how many can see an evidence that the mentax events of chapter 9 precede those of chapter 8? Does anyone see such an evidence as that? Well, I guess it must follow because we have two voting that it follows to none foting that it precedes. If you decide by a majority vote, it would be that way. What
