

not even into another species. The whole question of evolution is one of substantial evidence and much of it extremely shaky and uncertain circumstantial evidence. Yet the great bulk of our educated people today have become so ~~th~~ firmly convinced of evolution that they put absolute faith in it. It affects their attitudes on most every part of their lives. They think of human beings as mere animals constantly changing and therefore subject to no moral law. There is widespread faith ~~established~~ established simply because of the confidence which individuals have in other individuals who have made certain statements or suggestions. Faith is a very common thing in life. We are not asked to see whether we have faith. We would == we could not carry on life very long without some kind of faith. We are asked to examine ourselves whether we are in the faith.

It is very easy to have false faith. The word faith in the Bible is sometimes translated "believing" and sometimes "faithful". The noun is usually translated faith in the KJV, but the adj. is usually translated faithful. Now between having faith or believing and being faithful there ~~is~~ seems to be a tremendous difference. One wonders how the same word can have two such different meanings, yet when we look at the original Greek it is easy to see the reason. As early as Homer we find that the word has the sense of trust, and the sense of being worthy of ~~trust~~ trust. These two ideas are very closely related == trust, and to be worthy of trust. The basic idea of faith is not an idea simply of considering certain things to be true; it is the sense of believing on as one believes on Christ and is saved. It is the sense of putting trust in or having trust in. Faith is trust or confidence. Unless a man's life is so upset, so shakey, so undependable that he is headed for a nervous breakdown he has a great deal of faith, but does he have the ~~great~~ right kind of faith?²-

Toward the end of World War Two the great many Polish patriots were living as quietly as possible in the Polish capital of Warsaw. The city had already been under German occupation for two or three ~~year~~ years. Many parts of the city were in complete ruin.
