place where he is going to have unbelief shoved into his mind. I believe that is wrong for the Christian. Then there are seminaries which teach philosophy, human ideas, cisterns hewed out by men who are real Christians studying other systems hewed out by men who are not Christians. One can go and study there and the Lord may use them, but my idea is a seminary which is a Biblical seminary where we can learn to interpret the Word of God. And if we do God will give us new truth all our lives. We'll always have something fresh to give. Not the broken cisterns to pull something out of, but the living water of the stream that comes from this Book which is endless in what it will give us, if we make it primary. Shall we pray,

Our Father we pray that you will help us take advantage of the opportunities which you have made it possible to establish here. Our God we thank you for the Book you have given us, a Book originally in Greek and Hebrew. Help us to learn to know these languages not simply to be able to know what words mean but how to take words which have a range of meanings and examine that range and see what fits in particular contexts. Help us to learn to know the Book as a whole, to know the wonderful teaching of the Gospel of John, but also the teaching of the Book of Amoz and Zepheniah; the teachings of all the parts of the SCripture that mean so much and to get methods and tools so we can go on through our lives feeding on the living bread rather than simply dealing with the crusts of human ideas, human thoughts either now or through the ages. We ask in our Saviour's Name. Amen.
