We simply do not have the concept, we do not have the facts. So it is natural for non-Christians to say, These ideas are absurd; of course they cannot be proved. Well, man cannot understand it. There are concepts we don't have. Just as the concept of gravitation was unknown before the time of \_\_\_\_\_, and Kepler, and Newton. And probably ever would have become known if we had not been able to study the skies. Once you have the concept it is clear, but we did not have the concept. And there are doubtless concepts entering in here, but we have the propositional revelation that Jesus Christ is God, that Jesus is man, that He is fully God -- a complete God, but there is only one God. He is complete man. Natural like the rest of us except without sin. We can't understand it, but it is taught in Scripture and we believe it.

The strange thing is when you get into the area of eschatology, we have different groups that try to explain all the details of eschatology and the usual method of attacking the belief of other groups is to pick little points and to say, But how can that be? I don't understand how that during the millennium saved people and unsaved people -- people with resurrection bodies and people with natural bodies can live together on this earth! Therefore the whole thing must be wrong. I don't understand all the details about
