Now if I go and do this and it's wrong, I'm a terrible failure, a colossal failure, I'm the cause of my nation's being wrecked. But, he says, if Deborah goes, everybody knows it's her plan, not mine. Then he says, If we succeed there is plenty of glory for both of us. So I'm perfectly content to let her have the major glory, so long as we are delivered. If it fails, I'll probably be killed and there will be a terrible disaster, but she'll get the blame for it. I won't get the blame, I'm merely doing what she says. So, he says, If thou wilt go with me than I will go, but if thou wilt not go with me then I will not go.

(Student: Did you say an organic prophecy?)
